## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

The Indoor Bowls Hall has been well prepared for users, but there are some conditions that we have to abide by:

- ENTRY IS BY ONE DOOR ONLY, WHERE SANITIZERS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE REGISTRATION DESK PRIOR TO TAKING YOUR SEAT
- THE TABLES HAVE BEEN SPREAD OUT AND ONLY 4 PEOPLE ARE ALLOWED PER TABLE - TABLES AND CHAIRS ARE NOT TO BE MOVED
- SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE ADHERED TO AT ALL TIMES, AND THIS IS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT AS WE ARE SERVED OUR MORNING TEA
- PRIOR TO DEPARTURE TABLES AND CHAIRS THAT WE USE ARE TO BE WIPED DOWN WITH DISINFECTANT WIPES. THESE WILL BE PROVIDED, AND WE ASK MEMBERS TO WIPE THEIR OWN TABLE AND CHAIR PRIOR TO DEPARTURE.

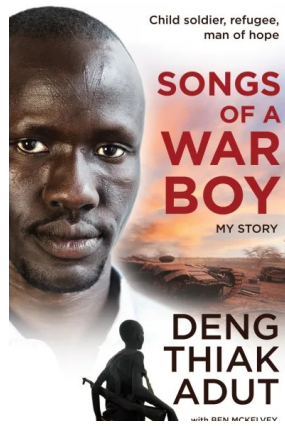
