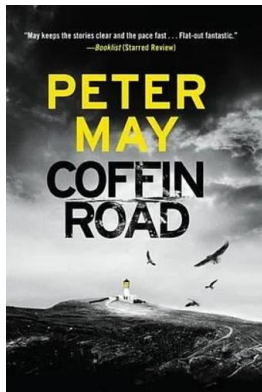
SET UP OF HALL FOR MEETINGS

- Money can also be direct deposited.

- Separate cheque, direct debit or cash payment for each activity.
Please do not combine cheque or cash payments in the same envelopes.
Each activity has to be reconciled and banked separately.
- **CANCELLATION OF YOUR BOOKING:** A SEPARATE NOTICE FOR FINAL DATE OF PAYMENT AND REFUND CUT-OFF DATE WILL BE GIVEN FOR EACH APPROPRIATE ACTIVITY. NO REFUNDS WILL BE POSSIBLE AFTER THAT DATE.

Fees and Activities Payment by Direct Bank Transfer - New Procedure for Payment Description

Standardised method for payment description

Payer - Who is making the Payment?

There is variation between the banks as to what information is automatically provided regarding the payer (some provide nothing). The only way to ensure that the club receives this information is to include it with the payment description. A family name (surname) will satisfy most of the membership. However we do have some members with a common family name. In such cases one initial will also be required. If the family name has a lot of characters, it may be necessary to shorten it to something that would be recognisable e.g. Sworth = Shuttleworth. This format of the shortening should be left for the individual payer to decide.

Activity / Fee Payment Code - What is the Payment For?

3 or 4 Characters will describe most of the club's activities.

The following are examples of how a **payment code** (name and purpose) may be formulated

Australia Day Picnic	(Family name) aud (year)	e.g. smithaud21
General Meeting Fee	(Family name) gm (month number)	e.g. smithgm4 (April meeting)
Annual Fee	(Family name) af (year)	e.g. smithaf21 (2021 fees)
BBQ Breakfast	(Family name) bbq (month number)	e.g. smithbbq4 (April bbq)
Trips	(Family name) payment code	e.g. smithnew (Newstead Trip) e.g. smithmol (Mooloolaba Trip) e.g. smithxij (Christmas in July)
Dineouts	(Family name) payment code	e.g. smithkbt (Kings Beach Tavern Lunch) e.g. smithxbu (Christmas Break Up)

NOTE

Members using this method of payment are totally responsible for the accuracy of the payment details they provide to their bank and for ensuring that the payer and its purpose can be identified in the clubs bank statement.

The club does not acknowledge the receipt of any such payment until it has been credited to and identified in the club's bank account
